- Study healthy vocal techniques related to posture, breathing and tone production as well as basic musicianship skills including music reading, singing in harmony, understanding music terms and identifying music symbols
- Support all students utilizing an inclusive, differentiated approach.
- Work with department professional learning communities within the school and district to further district mission and goals.
- Proven commitment to being a reflective educator committed to antiracist, and culturally responsive, curriculum and pedagogy
