The Unitersity of the Statent New York Education Absolute Charter of

Mess York State School Music Association

This instrument witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education

Department of the State of New York has granted this absolute charter

1. Incorporating Evin C. Freeman, Harry H. Hing, Robert C. Frant, John C. Kingon, William S. Groeling, Joseph Cleck, Roy & Wilfinson, Lovere Frompson, Victor Salvo, Arter J. Wilhousky and Marie Rusch and their associates and successors as an educational corporation under the corporate name of New York State School Music Association, the operations of the corporation to be conducted in the Istate of New York.

2. The purposes for which such corporation is formed are:

To estimulate interest in the study of muse in the public, private, and parochial schools of New York State;
 To score wider recognition of the educational values of music;
 So encourage a carry-ever of school music training into the musical, social and home life of the community as a vital part of its cultural, recreational and linear-time activities; and

cultural, recreationed and leibur-time activities; and

4. So foster professional growth, leadership and good fellowship among the members of the association.

3. The persons named as incorporators shall constitute the first board of trustees. The board shall have power to adopt bylaws including therein provisions fixing the method of election and the term of office of trustees, and shall have power also by wot of three-fourths of all the members of the board of trustees, to have nor than 28 nor less than five.

4. The corporation hereby created shall be a nonstock corporation organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes, and no part of the earnings or net income shall inture to the benefit of any individual, and no officer, member or employee of the corporation shall receive or be entitled to receive any peculiarry profit from the operations thereof, except reasonable compensation for services.

5. The principal office of the corporation is to be located in the city of Hornell, county of Steuben and State of Elev York, at the office of the executive secretary-treasurer of the association, or in such other place within the State of Elev York as shall be the location of the office of the executive secretary-treasurer.

6. The Commissioner of Schucation is besignated as the representative of the corporation upon whom process in any action proceeding against it may be served.
