CREATING (Cr)

Cr 1

Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and works.

Cr1.1 IMAGINE

The creative ideas, concepts, and feelings that influence musicians' work emerge from a variety of sources.

Cr 2

Organize and develop artistic ideas and work.

Cr2.1 PLAN, MAKE

Musicians' creative choices are influenced by their expertise, context, and expressive intent.

Cr 3 Refine and complete artistic work.

Cr3.1 EVALUATE, REFINE

Evaluate and refine selected musical ideas to create musical work that meets appropriate criteria.

Cr3.2 PRESENT

Share creative musical work that conveys intent, demonstrates craftsmanship, and exhibits originality.

PERFORMING (Pr)

Pr 4

Select, analyze, and interpret artistic work for presentation.

Pr4.1 SELECT

Performers' interest in and knowledge of musical works, understanding of their own technical skill, and the context of a performance influence the selection of repertoire.

Pr4.2 ANALYZE

Analyzing creators' context and how they manipulate elements of music provides insight into their intent and informs performance.

Pr4.3 INTERPRET

Performers make interpretive decisions based on their understanding of context and expressive intent.

Pr 5

Develop and refine artistic techniques works for presentation.

Pr5.1 REHEARSE, EVALUATE, REFINE

To express their musical ideas, musicians analyze, evaluate, and refine their performance over time through openness to new ideas, persistence, and the application of appropriate criteria.

Pr 6

Convey meaning through the presentation of artistic work.

Pr6.1 PRESENT

Perform expressively, with appropriate interpretation and technical accuracy, and in a manner appropriate to the audience and context.

CONNECTING (Cn)

Cn 10

Relate and synthesize knowledge and personal experiences to inspire and inform artistic work.

Cn10.1 RELATE

The multidimensional system of music allows us to uniquely express and reflect upon ideas, opinions, aesthetic values, and human sentience. Musicians draw upon universal themes, disciplinary and interdisciplinary understandings, and life experiences to inform their creative expressions.

Cn 11

Relate artistic ideas and works with societal, cultural, and historical context to deepen understanding.

Cn 11.1 INTERRELATE Creating, performing and analyzing music deepens our knowledge of ideas, informs our understanding of cultures, and helps us envision the future.

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RESPONDING (Re)

Re 7

Perceive and analyze artistic work.

Re7.1 SELECT

Individuals' selection of musical works is influenced by their interests, experiences, understandings, and purposes.

Re7.2 ANALYZE

Response to music is informed by analyzing context (social, cultural, and historical) and how creators and performers manipulate the elements of music.

Re 8

Interpret meaning in artistic work.

Re8.1 INTERPRET

Support interpretations of musical works that reflect creators'/performers' expressive intent.

Re9.1 EVALUATE

Support evaluations of musical works and performances, based on analysis, interpretation, and established criteria.
