The Director of the JCC Thurnauer School of Music shapes the school's vision and culture; and cultivates an inclusive and supportive environment for the staff team, students and families. In addition to their artistic and educational expertise, the ideal candidate will showcase effective leadership and management skills, financial acumen, and the ability to develop and maintain strong fundraising relationships.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES

Strategic Leadership & Philosophy: Define and uphold an overarching philosophy that cultivates a culture of excellence and inclusivity and shapes a vision that reflects the needs and interests of a diverse student body.

Operational Oversight: Manage the operations of the music department, creating and monitoring an annual budget of \$1.6M, and overseeing a team of four full-time staff members, six part-time staff members, and 55 faculty. Advance and monitor administrative processes, identify areas for improvement, and implement strategies to optimize operations while ensuring coordination and collaboration with the balance of Kaplen JCC departments.

Resource Development & Fundraising: Serve as lead fundraiser including stewarding current donors, identifying new donors, and managing grant and donation opportunities. Identify and pursue opportunities for foundation and government grant support and prepare compelling proposals to secure additional funding.

Program & Curriculum Development: Design and manage a comprehensive and age-appropriate music education curriculum, accessible to students of all ages and levels. Assess student progress, organize musical events, concerts and performances.

Faculty Recruitment, Management & Guidance: Recruit and hire faculty with strong pedagogical skills and a passion for teaching. Manage and inspire a team of professional educators in a collaborative environment that provides ongoing professional development and constructive feedback

Community & Family Engagement: Build meaningful relationships with parents, faculty, and JCC administrators, promoting open communication and a sense of community. Establish partnerships with local arts and music organizations and ensure a wide-reaching approach to recruitment and enrollment.
